LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION

The LCIF Disaster Relief grant program provides financial support to Lions and their partners engaged in natural disaster preparedness, response and recovery efforts. Disaster Preparedness grants offer US\$5,000 to US\$10,000 to districts interested in partnering with local authorities and other community organizations to plan and prepare for future disaster relief efforts. Community Recovery grants provide up to US\$20,000 for short-term clean-up and repair efforts in situations where other organizations have already addressed immediate needs.

Lions Clubs International, through our Foundation (LCIF), has responded with an emergency catastrophe grant in the amount of US\$100,000 for Hurricane Harvey relief. The grant will allow Lions in the area of impact to provide life-saving supplies of food, water, blankets and other necessities.
